1. Scope

This standard covers the requirements for aluminum, bolted, terminal connectors.

This standard applies to Seattle City Light (SCL) Stock No. 651214.

2. Application

Bolted connectors are used to connect 795 or 954 kcmil All Aluminum Conductor (AAC) or Aluminum Conductor Steel Reinforced (ACSR) to a flat, NEMA two-hole pad.

Bolted connectors may be used on lines or equipment up to 230 kV.

Torque hardware to 40 ft-lb.

- Two-hole NEMA pad
- Aluminum hardware, (captured U-bolts, split lock washers, and nuts)

Figure 4. Bolted Connector


