Marking Spray Paint with Reusable Spraying Device



1. Scope

This standard covers the requirements for water-based, air-drying paint dispensed in inverted spray cans with a reusable spraying device.

This standard applies to the following Seattle City Light (SCL) stock numbers:

2. Application

Paint shall be suitable for use on soil, grass, gravel, asphalt, concrete, wood, and metal for marking underground facilities, warning of construction site hazards, surveying, and other inverted spray uses. The reusable spraying device must be used with this product.

Empty cans may be disposed of as waste or recycled.

3. Requirements

Paint shall be water-based and hexane free.

Paint shall be formulated to dry within 15 minutes under normal conditions.

Cans shall be designed for inverted spray application.

4. Marking

Cases shall be marked with manufacturer name, product description, color, and SCL stock number.
