4. Requirements

Thickness, maximum	7.5 mils
Tensile strength (longitudinal lb/in of width, minimum)	19 lb/in
Ultimate elongation, min.	10%
Adhesion to steel (oz/in of width, minimum)	30 oz/in
Performance	When applied to a properly painted surface, tape shall strip clean, leaving no film or residue; tape shall also not strip off or remove any of the underlying paint coating.

Tape shall be packaged to prevent damage during shipping, storage, and casual handling prior to use.
