

## Skinning Knives



### 1. Scope

This standard covers the requirements for skinning knives. This standard applies to the following Seattle City Light (SCL) stock numbers:

764220	Knife, wooden handle
012244	Knife, ergonomic rubber handle

Skinning knives are used to remove insulation from wire or cable.

Skinning knives shall be of the styles shown in Figure 4 and meet the requirements of Table 4.

Skinning knives shall come with an accessory ring on handle, for hanging and attaching purposes.

#### 5. Packaging

Product shall be packaged to prevent damage during shipping, handling, and inside storage.

- Manufacturer name
- Manufacturer catalog number
- Product description
- SCL stock number

Shipping containers shall be legibly marked with SCL purchase order number.
