- Flashlight shall be impact- and water-resistant.
- Flashlight shall be professional grade, suitable for general purpose application in a utility environment.
- Flashlight shall have a built-in pocket clip.
- Flashlight shall have two magnets: one on the clip, the other on the base end of light for hands-free use.
- Flashlight shall be intrinsically safe.
- Flashlight shall have dual, independent operating push-button switches for spot beam, flood beam, or both beams simultaneously.
