1. Scope

This standard covers the requirements for personal, reusable water bottles.

This standard applies to Seattle City Light (SCL) Stock No. 014635.

2. Application

Water bottles are used to transport and seal drinkable liquid for a single person for hydration at jobsite or in the shop.

3. Requirements

Water bottles shall have the following attributes:

- Made from BPA-free TritanTM co-polyester plastic
- Single wall construction
- Color: apple green, clear, or blue
- Extra-wide mouth with tethered twist lid
- Storage Capacity: 32 oz to 34 oz
- Seattle City Light logo (stacked version) as shown in Figure 3:
 - o 3.25 in x 3.25 in
 - Imprint Color: Pantone Matching System (PMS) 293C (Cyan Blue) with black lettering
