## 2. Application

The product specified in this standard is for use during a heat event (a hot weather period when temperatures are at or above 89°F).

This standard is implemented in accordance with SCL Safety, Health, and Wellness Division (SHAW) standard SHW 23, *Outdoor Heat Exposure*. SHW 23 was written to meet the requirements of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC), including WAC 296-62-095 and the Emergency Rule filed on July 9th, 2021.

Cooling towels are used after strenuous activities to wipe and help cool down the body.

#### 3. Packaging

Product shall be packaged to prevent damage during shipping, handling, and inside storage.

Cartons shall be legibly marked with:

- Manufacturer name
- Manufacturer catalog number
- Product description
- SCL stock number

Shipping containers shall be legibly marked with an SCL purchase order number.
