

Cooling Towels



1. Scope

This standard covers the requirements for cooling towels.

This standard applies to Seattle City Light (SCL) Stock No. 014828.

2. Application

The product specified in this standard is for use during a heat event (a hot weather period when temperatures are at or above 80 degrees F).

This standard is implemented in accordance with SCL Safety, Health, and Wellness Division (SHAW) standard SHW 23, Outdoor Heat Exposure.

Cooling towels are used after strenuous activities to wipe and help cool down the body.

3. Packaging

Product shall be packaged to prevent damage during shipping, handling, and inside storage.

Cartons shall be legibly marked with:

- Manufacturer name
- Manufacturer catalog number
- Product description
- SCL stock number

Shipping containers shall be legibly marked with an SCL purchase order number.
