# Transformers, Low Voltage, Class 2



### 1. Scope

This standard covers the requirements for low voltage, Class 2 transformers. Low-voltage transformers are also known as signaling transformers. This material standard applies to Seattle City Light (SCL) Stock No. 733777.

### 2. Application

Low voltage, Class 2 transformers are used to supply power to door buzzers, SCL Stock No. 722176.

### 3. Industry Standards

Low voltage transformers shall meet the applicable requirements of the latest revision of the following industry standards:

- UL 5085-1; "Low Voltage Transformers Part 1: General Requirements"

### 4. Requirements


Low voltage transformers shall have the following attributes:

- Class 2 transformer
- 50/60 Hz frequency
- Non-negative thermal overload protection
- Grounding wire
- Pre-stripped primary-side pigtails
- Screw terminal connections for secondary
- Panel mount
- Mounting hole size 1-1/8 inch


