Labels, Cable Markers, Wraparound



1. Scope

This standard covers the material requirements for wraparound cable marker labels.

This standard applies to Seattle City Light (SCL) Stock No. 012510.

2. Application

Cable marker labels provide a visual aid in identifying communication cable or fiber optic aerial duct as being owned by SCL.

SCL owned pole attachments are labeled and identified as "001" in black numbering.

3. Requirements

Labels shall be designed to unroll and wrap around the existing cable easily and securely.

Labels shall be brightly colored for high visibility.

Labels shall meet the requirements of Table 3 and Figure 3.



Material	Coiled PVC plastic
Dimensions, nominal (in)	4 x 7, uncoiled
Color	Yellow, reflective
Lettering	1 inch black "001" numbering, per Figure 3.
Style	Wraparound, coiled
Fits Cable Size Diameter (in)	1 to 2.5
Design Life	UV resistance to remain readable for 7 years minimum, with outdoor exposure
