

Spill Supplies, Absorbent Socks



1. Scope

This standard covers the requirements for absorbent socks for oil-based and hazardous material-based spills.

This standard applies to the following Seattle City Light (SCL) stock numbers:

Stock No.	Description
756101	Sock, oil-absorbent, white, 3" x 48"
756102	Sock, oil-absorbent, white, 3" x 96"
756109	Sock, hazmat, yellow, 3" x 48"

2. Application

For use in spill events.

Stock Nos. 756101 and 756102 are for oil-based spills.

Stock No. 756109 is for absorbing hazardous material (chemicals, acids, and bases)-based spills.
