

Bags, Asbestos Disposal



1. Scope

This standard covers the requirements for plastic bags used in the disposal of asbestos materials.

This standard applies to the following Seattle City Light (SCL) stock numbers:

Stock No.	Description
761170	33" x 50", Asbestos Disposal Bag, Yellow
761172	36" x 60", Asbestos Disposal Bag, Yellow

2. Application

Asbestos disposal bags are used for containing, transporting, and disposal of asbestos-contaminated materials.

Double-bagging is required before bags are filled with waste.

3. Industry Standards

Bags shall meet the applicable requirements of the following industry standard:

4. Requirements

Bags shall be:

- Made of 6 mil thick yellow plastic
- Impermeable
- Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) approved for asbestos use and purpose
- Labeled with the following OSHA-approved warnings:
 - DANGER
 - CONTAINS ASBESTOS FIBERS
 - MAY CAUSE CANCER
 - CAUSES DAMAGE TO LUNGS
 - DO NOT BREATHE DUST
 - AVOID CREATING DUST
